### Youth Day 2008 RFP for Presentations

Federation of Protestant Welfare Agencies (FPWA) is pleased to announce the details of its 9<sup>th</sup> annual Youth Day, an exciting program that seeks to inspire, educate, and promote collaboration among youth-serving organizations, social service professionals, and young people.

Youth Day 2008 will be held on **Tuesday, November 4**, from 8:30am-4:00pm at the Federation of Protestant Welfare Agencies. As always, the conference program will feature a thought-provoking youth panel, dynamic youth performances, and innovative workshops led by social service providers and the youth with whom they work.

This year's theme is ***Making Dollars and Sense: Financial Literacy for Youth***, and our program will help youth tackle money matters, understand the importance of managing their financial life, and discuss what measures may be taken to address financial challenges.

We are currently accepting proposals from youth and youth-serving agency representatives interested in conducting interactive workshops about financial literacy for Youth Day. Workshop presenters will be expected to prepare a 90-minute session for as many as 30 participants. Workshops should cover topics related to the theme such as:

- Effectively managing money, budgeting, and financial planning
- Examining consumerism among youth, and youth spending habits
- The dangers of credit card debt and high interest
- Handling/Managing or escaping debt
- The importance of frugality when the nation is in recession or an "economic downturn"
- The various aspects of investment/investing
- The effects of inflation on spending and saving money

Please note that **no honoraria** will be provided for workshop presenters. However, presenters will receive breakfast and lunch for free.
